The success of your application will depend on the detail you provide on the forms, meeting the eligibility criteria below, and on merit when compared to the other applications received.

This year we will also come and meet with you so we are confident we understand your project.

Am I eligible?

You can apply to the **Sanford 10 cents a Salmon Fund** if you or your project meets the following criteria:

- The project is focused on the wellbeing of people and communities of Rakiura Stewart Island and Bluff, and
- The project is community-led (i.e. not a government departments and local council)
- The project will be funded for 1 year, if your project is for multiple years you will need to reapply each year.

What do we mean by wellbeing?

This fund is to help Rakiura Stewart Island and Bluff people and communities. We want to help you to bring people together, to provide fun, happiness, pride, care or safety. If you need funding for a community led project, sport, art, culture or health you should apply. This is not a fund for environmental projects.

How will my application be assessed?

Your application will be assessed on:

- The extent to which the wellbeing of the people and communities of Rakiura Stewart Island and Bluff will benefit
- The extent to which the project engages volunteers, the community and other stakeholders in the delivery, success or enjoyment from the project
- The likelihood of success, please demonstrating you have the required skills and capability to deliver the project and provide a reasonable and realistic project budget.

Key dates

Applications open each year on the **01 February** and close 8 weeks later at 5pm on the **31 March**.
