Peter Reidie has extensive primary sector experience. He is currently CEO of the Farmlands Cooperative Society, a position he has held for over five years. Previously, Mr Reidie was Managing Director for Australia and New Zealand at Goodman Fielder.

Mr Reidie said that a more prosperous Sanford will be good for the seafood industry as a whole and will ultimately contribute to New Zealand's exporting success.

Sir Rob McLeod said the Sanford Board wanted to publicly thank Andre Gargiulo for the excellent job he has done as acting CEO over the past few months, helping Sanford to adjust quickly to a dynamic environment.

Peter Reidie's start date at Sanford will be announced in the New Year. Mr Gargiulo will continue in the role of Sanford's Acting CEO until Mr Reidie joins the company.
